Storm Water Discharge National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System

PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE

MidAmerican Energy Company plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the **NPDES General Permit No. 2 “Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities.”**

The storm water discharge will be from the construction of access roads, crane paths, underground collection, wind turbines, a temporary laydown yard, a temporary concrete batch plant and a turbine staging area located in T87N R39W Sections 1-6; T87N R40W Sections 1-11, 14-20, and 29-30; T87N R41W Sections 1-4, 9-16, and 22-26; T88N R39W Sections 1-36; T88N R40W Sections 1-5, and 8-36; T88N R41W Sections 13-14, 22-27, and 33-36; T89N R39W Sections 27-29, and 31-36; T89N R40W Sections 35-36 in Ida County.

Stormwater will be discharged from approximately 100 point sources and will be discharged to the following streams: Silver Creek, Hog Run–Maple River, Battle Creek, Ashton Creek, Bacon Creek, Coon Creek, Moorhead Creek, Aldrich Creek–Maple River, Badger Creek–Maple River, Buffalo Creek–Maple River, Odebolt Creek, and Elk Creek.
