SUMMARY OF THE JULY 12, 2021, REGULAR MEETING OF THE ODEBOLT ARTHUR BATTLE CREEK IDA GROVE COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Odebolt Arthur Battle Creek Ida Grove (OABCIG) School Board met in regular session Monday, July 12, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. in the boardroom at the OABCIG High School in Ida Grove.

Stephanie Konradi, Board President, called the meeting to order, read the OABCIG mission statement, and the board recited the pledge of allegiance. Kathy Leonard, board secretary, conducted a roll call as follows: Tony Bennett, present; Crystal Endrulat, present; Lex Jacobson, present; Stephanie Konradi, present; Brad Lundell, present; Jeff Rasmussen, absent; and Stacy Raasch, present. Also attending the meeting were Matt Alexander, superintendent; Randy Sharp, representative of Estes Construction; Jacob Pedersen, high school vocal instructor; and Brian Waller.

It was moved by Lundell and seconded by Endrulat to approve the agenda as published and the motion carried 6-0. Konradi welcomed visitors. Pedersen spoke about the proposed spring music trip.

It was moved by Lundell and seconded by Endrulat to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes; claims totaling \$7,285,795.22; resignations from Brenda Mace, Odebolt head cook; and approval of the high school music event to Omaha on Sunday, April 3, 2022. The motion carried

6-0.

Sharp gave an update on the construction project at the high school and answered questions. Alexander reported that most of his time has been spent on the construction site and the push to have the project completed by deadline. He recently attended a meeting with guidance counselors and a Mental Health agency in Carroll, trying to set up services for next year, and stated, in August, the board could be approving a 28E agreement with Galva-Holstein and Ida County for a resource officer if documents are finished at that time.

It was moved by Lundell and seconded by Bennett to approve the administration's recommendation to appoint Doug Mogensen and Jo Lyons as the Level I investigators and the Sac County Sheriff's Department as the Level II investigator for the Odebolt building and Alan Henderson and Julie Staley as the Level I investigators and the Ida County Sheriff's Department as the Level II investigator for the Ida Grove Buildings for the FY 21-22 School Year. The motion carried 6-0.

It was moved by Endrulat and seconded by Lundell to appoint the Ida County Courier as the official newspaper of the OABCIG School District for FY 2021-2022. The motion carried 6-0.

It was moved by Jacobson and seconded by Lundell to approve the appointment of Kathy Leonard as Board Secretary and Treasurer, and Franck, Sextro & Blazek, P.L.C. Law Firm as Board Counsel for the 2021-2022 school year for OABCIG Schools. The motion carried 5-0, with Bennett

abstaining. Konradi administered the oath of office to Leonard.

It was moved by Bennett and seconded by Raasch to approve updated board policies as recommended by IASB for the OABCIG School District so policies will take effect immediately. The motion carried 6-0.

It was moved by Lundell and seconded by Jacobson to approve the change orders for the high school project for a net increase of \$16,170.75 for the OABCIG School District. The motion carried 6-0.

Discussion items included the November school board election, district credit card rebate, donation from Chuck Riley for the high school library, net revenue from Medicaid and the shortage of cooks and bus drivers. Brian Waller spoke to the board about ideas on memorials for Jon Lageschulte. It was the consensus of the board to have Mr. Alexander gather information on the needs of the track program. A lengthy discussion was held on the proposed transfer of land from OABCIG Schools to the City of Odebolt for ballfield use. Members of the committee will be asked to attend a future board meeting with more detailed plans on the use of the land.

The next regular meeting will be held Monday, August 9, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. in the boardroom at the high school.

It was moved by Jacobson and seconded by Raasch to adjourn. The motion carried 6-0 and the meeting adjourned at 7:55 p.m. Kathy A. Leonard, OABCIG Board Secretary
