UTILITY RATE—WATER—Following discussion, motion by Freese second by Wiese to raise the minimum rate per month per hook-up to \$40.85 per 3,000 gallons. All ayes. Motion carried.

UTILITY RATE—WASTEWATER—Following discussion, motion by Brosamle to increase the sewer rate to \$60 per month. Motion died for lack of a second.

Motion by Brosamle to raise the sewer rate to \$50 per month, second by Cunningham. All ayes. Motion carried. The council also discussed increasing the disconnect/reconnect fee.

SALARY RESOLUTION—ADD LIBRARY DIRECTOR—Motion by Brosamle, second by Freese, to add Library Director Naberhaus to the 2021/2022 salary Resolution

and remove retired Director Niemeier. All ayes. Motion carried.

APPROVE LIBRARY BOARD MEMBERS CAITLYN MOELLER & VANESSA HARDER—Motion by Freese, second by Cunningham to appoint Caitlyn Moeller and Vanessa Harder to the Galva Public Library Board to fulfill the terms of resigning members Emily Sauter and Courtney Powell. All ayes. Motion carried.

28 E AGREEMENT—COUNTY-WIDE LAW—The Mayor talked with the council about the Public Safety Meeting and renewing the 28E County Wide Law Agreement. It was suggested to have the City Attorney review the proposed agreement.

CD 4428 RENEWAL—Motion by Freese second by Cunningham to renew CD 4428 for 12 months. All ayes. Motion carried.

SOUTH VIEW ALFALFA—Motion by Freese second by Wiese to approve Brad Andresen to bale the alfalfa in South View. All ayes. Motion carried.

NIRHA CITY REPRESENTATIVE HOUSING AUTHORITY—Motion by Freese second by Cunningham to appoint Council member Wiese to Northwest Iowa Regional Housing Authority. All ayes. Motion carried.

BUILDING PERMIT—401 W. COUNTY ROAD—The application was not turned in to city hall for the council to discuss.

BUILDING PERMIT—106 Crawford St.—Fence—This permit was approved upon motion by Freese second by Brosamle as long as they adhere to the 2' set-aside along the alley. All ayes. Motion carried.

BUILDING PERMIT—208 Woodbury St.—Addition to garage—Motion by Brosamle second by Wiese to approve the building permit as long as they follow the set aside as per Galva Code of Ordinances.
