Lampman made a motion, second by Fried. All ayes. Motioned carried.

Resolution # 03.2023 BE IT RESOLVED that the Arthur City Council re-appoint current employees at the current wages for the City of Arthur, Iowa. A motion was made by Fried, second Lampman. All ayes. Motion carried.

Resolution # 04.2023 BE IT RESOLVED that the Arthur City Council approves the appointment of Mid-America Publishing Corp. as the official newspaper of the city of Arthur. Arbegast made a motion, second by Lampman. All ayes. Motion carried.

Resolution # 05.2023 A motion was made by Arbegast to set

the public hearing date for the maximum property tax dollars for 2/06/2023, second by Fried. All ayes. Motion carried.

Resolution # 06.2023 A motion was made by Lampman to set the public hearing date for the budget amendment for 2/06/2023, second by Arbegast. All ayes. Motion carried.

Arbegast made a motion to appoint Chase as the E911 Board Appointee second by Fried. All ayes. Motion carried.
