CITY OF IDA GROVE COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, JAN. 3, 2023 5:30 p.m. TEMPORARY CITY HALL 311 BARNES STREET

1. Call to Order: Mayor Protem, Gregor Ernst, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. Roll Call: Present: Gregor Ernst, Jeff Miesner, Jared Bogue, Ange Johnson. Jason Schable was absent.

3. Approval of Agenda: Motion by Miesner to approve, second by Bogue. Motion carried 4-0.

4. 2023 Appointments: Motion by Bogue to appoint Heather Sweeden as City Clerk, second by Johnson. Motion carried 4-0. Sweeden took the Oath of Office administered by Ernst. Motion by Johnson to appoint Scott Van Dusen as Fire Chief, second by Miesner. Motion carried 4-0. Van Dusen took the Oath of Office administered by Ernst. Motion by Miesner to appoint Peter Goldsmith, Laurel Boerner, Justin Reininger and Ryan Gaskins as City Attorneys, second by Bogue. Motion carried 4-0. Motion by Bogue to appoint Gregor Ernst as Mayor Protem, second by Miesner. Motion carried 4-0.

5. Public Hearing for Zoning Use Amendment to General Industrial: Motion by Johnson to open the public hearing at 5:37 p.m., second by Boque. Motion carried 4-0. No comments were received. Council discussed the recommendation from Planning and Zoning as follows: addition of a special use to General Industrial Section 17.10.070 (2) (d) "Railroad right-of-way, including a strip of land for tracks and accessory facilities for track operations only." Motion by Bogue to close the public hearing at 5:39 p.m., second by Johnson. Motion carried 4-0. Motion by Bogue to accept the recommendation from Planning & Zoning, adding a special use under General Industrial, second by Ernst. Motion carried 4-0.

6. Ethan Joy - Ferguson Enterprises Pay App #5: Motion by Johnson to approve pay application #5 to Ferguson Enterprises in the amount of \$54,092.95, second by Bogue. Motion carried 4-0.

 Consent Agenda: Motion by Miesner to approve the consent agenda consisting of the following: Clerk's Report, claims in the amount of \$156,332.62, financial reports, and minutes of the 12/19/2022, 12/21/2022 & 12/28/2022 meetings, second by Bogue. Motion carried 4-0.

8. Resolution 2023-1 Naming Official Newspaper: Motion by Bogue to approve Resolution 2023-1, second by Johnson. Motion carried 4-0.

9. Resolution 2023-2 Naming Depositories: Motion by Johnson to approve Resolution 2023-2, second by Ernst. Motion carried 4-0.

10. Resolution 2023-3 Setting Public Hearing on FY23 Budget Amendment #2 - Jan. 16, 2023 5:30 p.m.: Motion by Bogue to approve Resolution 2023-3, second by Johnson. Motion carried 4-0.

11. Ida County Public Safety & Communications Commission: Motion by Ernst to appoint Johnson as voting representative and Schable as alternate voting representative, second by Miesner. Motion carried 4-0.

12. 2023 IRS Mileage Reimbursement Rate: The IRS issued an updated rate of .655/mile after the agenda was published. Motion by Johnson to approve the IRS mileage reimbursement rate for 2023 as .655/mile, second by Miesner. Motion carried 4-0.

13. 2023 Health Insurance Premiums: With health insurance premiums doubling for 2023, the Administration Committee met and reviewed ways to ease the burden to employees. Sweeden explained there is an excess balance in the employee benefits fund that has been built up over a number of years and can only be spent on limited things, such as insurance premiums. Council heard the following recommendation from the Administration Committee: City pays 100% of employee premium and 75% of family insurance premium. The City will pay the first \$1,000 (single)/\$2,000 (family) of the deductible; employee pays the next \$2,000/\$4,000 and the City will pay the final \$2,000/\$4,000. Committee members want to ensure that employees understand this is only temporary as a way to ease the cost burden since funds are currently available and should plan accordingly for future years. Motion by Miesner to approve

the recommendation from the Administration Committee, second by Bogue. Motion carried 4-0.

14. Mayor Vacancy: With Devlun Whiteing's resignation effective 1/1/2023, a Mayor should be appointed by March 1, 2023.

15. City Council Member News & Notes: Sheriff Harriman provided a law enforcement and FY2024 budget update.

16. Adjournment: Motion by Johnson to adjourn, second by Bogue. Motion carried 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 6:48 p.m.
