Approval of Agenda: Motion by Ernst, second by Miesner. Motion carried 4-0. Public Hearing - FY 2026 Budget Amendment #1: Motion by Ernst second by McLead to open the public hearing at 5:30 p.m. Motion carried 4-0. No comments were received. Motion by Miesner, second by Ernst to close the public hearing at 5:32 p.m. Motion carried 4-0. Resolution 2025-39 Adopting FY26 Budget Amendment #1: Motion by Ernst, second by McLead to approve. Motion carried 4-0. Devlun Whiteing, Ida County Board of Supervisors - Request for Speed Study: Whiteing presented on behalf of the Ida County Board of Supervisors, requesting the City Council approve initiating a speed study on Highway 175, particularly the eastern portion near the in tersection of Gomaco and Harold Godbersen Drive. Per the Iowa DOT, although this area is outside of city limits, the City must initiate the study as any speed changes could shift the zones through town The study would consist of reviewing years of data, is of no cost to

the city or county and would help

determine if the current speed limits are appropriate. Motion by McLead second by Bogue to initiate a speed study on Highway 175, as shown on the attached map, essentially spanning from Zimmy's to the eastern most entrance of Gomaco. Motion carried 5-0. Consent Agenda: Motion by Ernst, second by Miesner to approve the consent agenda consisting of the following: claims in the amount of \$159,054.26, financials, minutes of the 7/21/2025 meeting permits and correspondence. Motion carried 5-0. 402-406 Second Street Future Plans: Bedrock Gravel completed demolition and site clearing of 402-406 Second Street on July 31, 2025. Council thoroughly discussed what should happen next regarding stabilization of the remaining exposed east wall, shared with Gomaco Museum, the exposed wall of the property at 408 Second Street and the public sidewalk which appears to have hollow areas beneath it. Motion by Miesner, second by Ernst to sell the empty lot as is, with conditions for the potential buyer. Miesner indicated his thoughts behind the motion is that every step depends on the future use of the property. After further debate, Miesner moved to rescind his original motion, second by Ernst. Motion by McLead, second by Ernst to hire a licensed engineer to complete an analysis of the remaining wall on the east side, reassessment of structural stability of 408 Second Street building and guidance on the public sidewalk Motion carried 5-0 408 Second Street - Future Plans: A prior engineering study indicated this property to be structurally sound. Post demolition of 402-406 Second Street, the council has ordered for

an updated report on structural stability before deciding how to move forward. Motion by Miesner, second by Schable to ready the property for sale, pending results of the structural analysis and including stipulations that a buyer would be required to put a new roof on the structure within a year as well as provide a business plan to the council. Council was in agreeance of the idea, but differed on the topic of timing. Ayes: Ernst, Miesner, Schable. Nays: Bogue & McLead. Motion carried 3-2. King Construction Pay App #20, Final & Retainage \$30,000: JEO completed a final walkthrough with King Construction this afternoon. All remaining punch list items have been addressed and the 2021 Water Improvements Project is now completed. JEO recommends approval of the final pay application as submitted. Motion by Bogue, second by McLead to approve final payment to King Construction. Motion carried 5-0. Elm & Maple Street Lots: Council members discussed potential stipulations to include as part of an agreement for selling the 6 lots owned by the City. Sweeden will present a draft agreement on an upcoming agenda hased on feedback provided during the meeting. City Council Member News & Notes: Schable asked about progress of the E 2nd Street reconstruction project. Adjournment: Motion by Ernst, second by Miesner to adjourn at 6:33 p.m. Motion carried 5-0.
