PROCEEDINGS: IDA GROVE CITY COUNCIL • JULY 21 MINUTES

City of Ida Grove **Council Meeting Minutes** Monday, July 21, 2025 • 5:30 p.m.

City Hall, 403 3rd Street Call to Order: Mayor Nathan Weitl called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Roll Call: Council present: Gregor Ernst, Jason Schable & Reynold McLead. Councilmen absent: Jared Bogue & Jeff Miesner. Others in attendance: JEO's Danny Sturm & Ethan Joy, Fire Chief Scott Van Dusen, David Forbes, Attorney Justin Reininger and City Clerk Heather Sweeden. Approval of Agenda: Motion by Ernst, second by Schable to approve the agenda, moving agenda item #11 prior to topic #9. Motion carried 3-0. **Ethan** Joy - JEO Consulting - 2021 Water Improvement Project Engineering Amendment #3: Motion by Ernst, second by McLead to approve amendment #3 in the amount of \$64,524. Motion carried 3-0. Danny Sturm - JEO Consulting a. Main Street Bridge - Construction Route: Sturm presented three detour options during reconstruction of the Main Street Bridge as follows: #1 - detour route using 260th Street and Keystone Avenue, including dust control surface treatment and signage at an estimated cost of \$15,000; #2 - phasing construction to complete one lane at a time, leaving one lane open for ingress/egress to and from Zobel's Addition at an estimated cost of \$200,000+ and additional 60-90 days for project completion; #3 temporary stream crossing which is estimated to cost an additional \$200,000+ and is not feasible due to the amount of traffic. The project is estimated to take up to 90 days using options #1 or #3 and up to 180 days using option #2. Ernst inquired about obtaining easements for an alternate route through the 800 block of Valley View Drive to 7th Street. Sturm estimated at least an additional \$50,000 in gravel costs for this method, not including legal costs and potential fees to the property owners. Sturm recommended option #1, understanding driving gravel isn't the most preferred method for everyone, but taking costs and construction time into account believes it to be the best option. Motion by McLead, second by Schable to move forward with op-

tion #1 detour on 260th/Keystone.

Motion carried 3-0. b. E Second

Street Subgrade: Due to extremely soft subgrade conditions at the conjunction of John Montgomery Drive and E. Second Street, two options were presented as follows: install subdrain with geogrid and rock at an estimate of \$80,330 or using cement stabilization (cement powder ground into the dirt to harden it) \$40,446. Motion by Ernst, second by Schable to approve cement stabilization estimated at \$40,446. Motion carried 3-0. c. E Second Street Concrete Testing: Motion by McLead, second by Schable to approve CTS quote for concrete testing on E. Second Street, not to exceed \$3.100. Motion carried 3-0. Nathan & Jessi Oldham - Incompliance with Terms of Agreement Regarding Great Dane, Request for Extension: Council reviewed photos provided of fence completion and proof of the Great Dane's enrollment into obedience training. The topic will be placed on the Dec 15, 2025 agenda; no action taken. Ida Grove Community Foundation - Special Event Application: David Forbes, on behalf of the Ida Grove Community Foundation, requested approval of a special event fundraiser for the King Theatre. The event, American Graffiti Car Show and Movie, is scheduled for Tuesday, Aug. 12 and consists of a car show, silent auction, movie and other activities. The request includes street closure on Second Street from the Theatre to Main Street and the parking spaces on the east side of Main Street from 1st to 3rd Street, beginning at 5 p.m. and ending around 7 p.m. at the start of the movie. With the event being a community fundraiser, the application fee was requested to be waived. Motion by Ernst, second by McLead to approve the application as submitted and waive the application fee. Motion carried 3-0. Consent Agenda: Motion by Ernst, second by McLead to approve the consent agenda consisting of the following: Clerk's Report, claims in the amount of \$362,759.41, financials, minutes of the 7/7/2025 & 7/16/2025 meetings, Class C w/ outdoor service 5 day event alcohol license for Lucky Wife Wine Slushies at Godbersen Park effective 7/22/2025 & 8/4/2025, permits and correspondence. Motion carried 3-0. Resolution 2025-38 Setting Date of Public Hearing for FY26

Budget Amendment #1 - Aug. 4, 2025: Motion by McLead, second by Ernst to approve. Motion carried 3-0. City Compost Pile: Information and costs were presented for updating the surveillance system and will be further discussed at the next meeting. Motion by Ernst, second by Schable to reopen the compost pile effective July 22, 2025. Motion carried 3-0. Fire Department - Purchase 30 Pagers: Motion by Ernst, second by Schable to approve purchase of 30 pagers as presented, to be paid with Equipment Depreciation Funds. Motion carried 3-0. 2021 Water Improvements Project - King Construction: Joy provided a punch list item completion update, noting there are a couple minor items left to complete. 402-406 Second Street Demolition Agreement: At a special meeting on July 16, 2025 City Council voted to demolish the City Owned building located at 402-406 Second Street, deemed by Bill Murphy, JEO Consulting (licensed engineer) to be in an advanced progressive failure state, at an emergency level. The engineering report further states "the building is currently a Life Safety Hazard and could cause serious loss or injury to the public and City". Motion by Ernst, second by Schable to approve the attached Deconstruction, agreement for Demolition and Removal of the Building and its Contents located at 402-406 Second Street, with Bedrock Gravel, in an amount not to exceed \$225,000, under lowa Code 384.103, deeming this a necessity of life and safety and failure to move forward would cause injury or loss to the City. Motion carried 3-0. City Council Member News & Notes: City Hall will be closed to the public for a couple days the week of Aug. 11 and Aug. 18 for staff to attend training on the new accounting software. Notice will be posted as soon as City Hall is provided specific dates and times. Adjournment: Motion by McLead, second by Schable to adjourn at 7:15 p.m. Motion carried 3-0.
