Whiteing called the meeting to order. A motion to approve minutes from July 15, 2025, by Schubert, seconded by Whiteing. Motion carried all voting Aye. There were no public comments to the board.  
County Engineer Jeff Williams, Assistant Engineer Colin Ryan and EMS Director Corey Trucke were present to discuss the removal of the EMS shed by secondary roads.
