The Odebolt Arthur Battle Creek Ida Grove (OABCIG) School Board met for the Regular Meeting on Monday, Dec. 12, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. in the boardroom at the OABCIG High School in Ida Grove.

Call to Order – President Konradi called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The board recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Julia Mogensen, Board Secretary, conducted a roll call as follows: Present: Goodman, Konradi, Rasmussen, Petersen, and Lundell. Absent: Loger and Jacobson.

Also attending the meeting were Matt Alexander, Superintendent, and Julia Mogensen, Board Secretary.

Approval of Agenda - It was moved by Lundell, seconded by Rasmussen to approve the agenda of the Regular Meeting. The motion carried 5/0.

Welcome Visitors – President Konradi welcomed Julie Weeda, Mistaya Hoefling, Christie Van Houten, Wyatt Van Houten, Staci Rohlk, Mary Morgan, Olivia Lampman, Payton Lampman, and Kevin Lampman.

Public Comments to the Board: Mr. Kevin Lampman addressed the board regarding overlapping activities on the school activities calendar and the possibility of future grade-alike buildings.

Approval of Consent Agenda - It was moved by Lundell and seconded by Goodman to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes, claims totaling \$597,065.26, and a resignation from paraeducator Erin Bengford. Motion carried 5/0.

Board Reports - The board reviewed Administrator and Director reports. Mrs. Hoefling introduced TAG teacher, Mrs. Rohlk. Mrs. Rohlk brought students Wyatt Van Houten, Olivia Lampman, and Payton Lampman to share their

experiences in the TAG program with the board. Mr. Alexander reported on bus inspections and recent superintendent meeting topics.

Approve Early Retirement Package FY22-23 - Rasmussen moved to approve the recommended proposal to offer a Voluntary Early Retirement Program for 3 (three) Certified Staff, 3 (three) Non-Certified Staff, and 1 (one) Admin/Director effective for the 2022-2023 school year. Second by Lundell. Ayes: Lundell, Rasmussen, Goodman, Konradi, and Petersen. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Paraprofessional Pay Adjustment - Lundell moved to approve an increase of \$2.00/hour for the starting paraprofessional pay wage and for all currently employed paraprofessionals in the OABCIG School District, effective Jan. 1, 2023. Second by Rasmussen. Ayes: 5. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Appoint Director to serve on the Ida County Conference Board - Goodman moved to appoint Director Jacobson to the Ida County Conference Board for 2023. Second by Lundell. Ayes: 5. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Appoint Director to serve on the Sac County Conference Board - Rasmussen moved to appoint Director Loger to the Sac County Conference Board for 2023. Second by Petersen. Ayes: 5. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Approve Drop Out/At Risk Prevention Plan - Lundell moved to approve the Drop Out/At Risk Prevention Plan for OABCIG Community School for the 2023-24 School Year. Second by Goodman. Ayes: 5, Nays 0, motion carried.

Approve Application for Modified Supplemental Amount-Drop Out/At Risk - Goodman moved to approve the request to the School Budget Review Committee (SBRC) for Modified Supplemental Amount and Supplemental Aid for the 2023-2024 Dropout Prevention Program in the amount of \$10,354 for expenditures necessary to implement the At Risk and Drop out Prevention Program plans as

approved by the OABCIG CSD. Second by Rasmussen. Ayes: 5. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Discussion and Correspondence - Director Petersen shared information from the Iowa School Board Association's annual conference which she and two other directors attended in November. Dir. Petersen recommended all board members continue attending the annual conferences for the excellent educational information presented.

Confirm Dates and Time of Next Meetings - The next regular meeting will be held Monday, Jan. 9, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. in the boardroom at the high school.

It was moved by Goodman and seconded by Petersen to adjourn. The motion carried 5/0 and the meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
