The Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on Nov. 12, 2025, at 9 a.m. Members present Devlun Whiteing, Creston Schubert and Kyle Rohlk. Whiteing called the meeting to order. A motion to approve minutes from Oct. 28, 2025, by Schubert, seconded by Rohlk. Motion carried all voting Aye.		
There were no public comments made to the board.		
The First-Tier canvass took place, the board examined the Tally List and Certification of Precinct Officials of the City/School Election held on Nov. 4, 2025. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the results of said are as follows. Approval of Agenda - It was moved by Goodman, seconded by Jacobson, to amend the agenda of the Regular Meeting moving item 4, Public Comments, after item 6, Board Reports. Ayes: 6. Nays: 0. Motion carried.

Welcome Visitors - The board welcomed several visitors.

Public Comments to the Board: Following the Agenda Approval, Curriculum Report, and Superintendent Report, the following community members addressed the board in support of a school sponsored high school soccer program: Gregor Ernst, Chase Miesner, Bodi Eason, Christie Van Houten, Jackson Groth, Christine Boysen, Lauren Schmidt, Jon Devitt, Andrea Salisbury, Deb Ullrich, and Sawyer Schmidt.
